Annual Program Related Student Outcomes

Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program (CMHC): In 2024-2025, 70 CMHC students graduated from the program, and the program completion rate was 78%. During this same period, 95% of students who sat for the on-campus administration of the National Counselor Examination, the standardized examination required for Texas Licensure as a Professional Counselor (NCE), passed the exam. Of CMHC graduates who responded to follow-up surveys, 100% who wished to be employed were employed in counseling or a closely related field within six months of graduation.

Master's School Counseling Program (SC): In 2024-2025, 8 SC students graduated from the program, and the program completion rate was 80%. During this same period, 100% of students who sat for the TExES-School Counselor, the examination required for Texas Certification as a School Counselor, passed the exam. Of SC graduates who responded to follow-up surveys, 100% who wished to be employed were employed in counseling or a closely related field within six months of graduation.

Counselor Education and Supervision Program (CES; PhD): In 2024-2025, 8 CES students graduated from the program and the program completion rate was 90.9%. Of Doctoral Program graduates who responded to follow-up surveys, 100% who wished to be employed were employed in counseling or a closely related field within six months of graduation.
